Recently we have been getting queries, emails and texts asking a variety of Blue Chevalier questions. Let me summarize some of those responses. Always keep in mind, that the Blue Chevalier Project is a grass-roots program to support law enforcement in our communities. We support the Nationale Law Officer of the Year but that falls under the Special Awards Program at Nationale.

- Who may join the Blue Chevaliers?—All Voyageurs and Dames may join. We also have "Non-Member Supporters". This may include a family member, other veterans not in the Forty and Eight, and community members in support of law enforcement. We have a few non-veteran police officers as members. We have had instances of when a Blue Chevalier award is given, that the officer is also given a membership into the Blue Chevaliers—being presented their certificate as well as a membership card and maybe even a patch or decal.

- Who may be recommended for an award? - This may include a single officer for a specific achievement or a group such as—a squad or team that is deserving of an award, an entire precinct or command center. Individually we may also consider military policeman, ICE or Custom Agents, Constables, Border Patrol, and many who hold law officer or peace officer credentials. If you live near a military base, contact the local Garrison Command or Provost Marshall to obtain points of contact within the Military Police

Command Structure to see if there are any deserving MPs.

- How are awards submitted? - We have a specific application form. It is a one page submission that may be typed or even handwritten. We have received applications with attachments such as letters of commendation, letters from supervisors, news articles or a simple submission written by the Locale as to why this officer is deserving.

- Does the person submitting the award have to be a member of the Blue Chevaliers?—The application at the bottom has the information of the person submitting the award and for the most part should be a Blue Chevalier—but we are not going to deny a deserving officer if not.

- Most asked question! When will Blue Chevaliers become a program? We are working diligently with the Finance Committee and others on any remaining requirements. This is to keep the faith with our members and all those in support of the Blue Chevaliers Project. Our numbers are growing!

Take a look at your card, some cards may indicate "Charter Member" but not have a date beyond the small red 2022 on it. I still have my original charter card, but since renewing, my newer card has a specific date. I talked to a member who thought that as a "Charter Member" they were done paying dues. Obviously this is
